## HIGHER EDUCATION VISA (SUBCLASS 573) ASSESSMENT LEVEL 3 APPLICATION DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

This document lists the information and supporting documents required to lodge your student visa application. It also lists additional documents that you may need to provide depending on your individual circumstances.

**Important**: Visa application requirements differ from one country to another. If you are applying outside Australia, you must contact your nearest departmental office and **check exactly how to submit your application and what documents to provide.**

**Important**: Do not provide original documents unless requested. You must provide certified copies of original documentation. Documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations. For more information on certified documents and English translation:

d)	Certified copies of passport or travel documents of all people included in the application. Passports must not have expired. If you are asked to attend a DIMA office you must bring your passport.

a)	Four recent passport sized photographs (45mmx35mm) of you and any other person included in the application.	
	<ul> <li>These photographs should be of the head and shoulders only against a plain background.</li> <li>Print the name of the person on the back of each photograph.</li> </ul>	
b)	Evidence of the relationship between yourself and all members of your family unit.	
	<ul> <li>Example:</li> <li>Certified copies or notarised copies of birth certificates (including those who are not joining you in Australia).</li> <li>Marriage certificate.</li> </ul>	
c)	If you are living in a de facto relationship, independent evidence that you have been in the relationship for at least 12 months.	
	<ul><li>Example:</li><li>Joint bank account statements.</li><li>Billing accounts in joint names.</li></ul>

d)	If you or anyone included in the application has been divorced or widowed, a certified copy of the divorce decree absolute or the death certificate of the deceased spouse (as appropriate).		
e)	If anyone in the application has changed his or her name, certified copies of documents verifying the name change.		
	<ul> <li>Example:</li> <li>Marriage or deed poll certificate.</li> <li>A certified copy of evidence of the name change.</li> </ul>		
f)	If any dependent child included in the application is adopted, certified copies of the adoption papers.		
g)	Certified copies of documents to verify custody and access arrangements for children under 18 years of age. This is not required if both parents are included in the application.		
h)	If your family members have turned 5 years of age, but have not yet turned 18, and are remaining with you in Australia, you will need to provide evidence of enrolment in an Australian school, including payment of any required fee.

Yo	You must provide <b>one</b> of the following:		
a)	Medical and X-ray examinations for yourself and any family unit member planning to remain with in you Australia; <b>or</b>		
b)	Evidence of a booking, or receipt, from Heath Services Australia (HSA) for your medical and X-ray examinations.

OR	Academic transcripts showing that you have <b>successfully completed a substantial part</b> of a course leading to a qualification from the Australian Qualifications Framework at Certificate IV level or higher as the holder of a student visa not more than 2 years before your visa application.  Note: This does not include foundation courses.			
OR	Academic transcripts that show you have in Australia and not more than 24 months prior to your visa application completed a foundation course.			
OR	Academic transcripts that show you have studied in English for 5 years or more in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the Republic of Ireland, the United Kingdom, the United States of America or South Africa.
